(SAM) Activity

The following activity might be used with groups of formal/informal science/literacy educators, in conjunction with reading the [95% Solution](#), in order to spark an awareness and discussion of the concept that science is all around us.

Share an Image

1. Download the [Science Around ME app](#).
2. Share an image (from your phone, tablet, or laptop), that connects you to science.

Write About the Science

1. How does this image connect you to science?
2. What is one thing that you know or think about science as related to this image/ in your daily life?
3. What is a science-related question you have about this image?

Group Share-out

Share your image and writing with your group.

Reflection

- Did anything about this activity (reviewing your own photos/writing about the science in them/seeing and hearing about the photos of others) surprise, delight, or otherwise make an impression on you?
- What is the value of looking for/seeing evidence of science around you?
- How might educators use/adapt such an activity with young people?
- What is one take away you have from this activity?
