Sharing *Intersections* Initiative Science-Literacy Project Plans

MODIFIED CHARRETTE

This is an adaption of the Charette, a protocol designed to allow groups to offer support in improving on a piece of work in progress.

Each of the sites takes a turn sharing and receiving response on their plan for their *Intersections* project. Each site gets **25 minutes** for this process.

7 min. A team presents their current *Intersections* project plan, along with thinking from yesterday's design activity and a need or request to the response group. This need or request is often formed as a question such as:

How can we address the challenge of . . . ?

How can we involve more voices in our planning process?

5 min. The response group asks any clarifying questions.

8 min. The response group discusses the plan while the presenting team takes notes and listens without engaging in the discussion.

5 min. The presenting team ends by summarizing what they heard from the response group.
